For the last several years I have been involved with a group trying to get action to reduce nutrient loading in Muskrat Lake in the Ottawa River Valley.

One thing that I've noticed is that there's no clear accountability for water quality. The Fisheries act should be revised to reflect accountability.

In Ontario supposedly the MOECC is accountable to maintain water quality but realistically it is just not happening. Our lakes are being taken over by high nutrient levels and hence algal blooms which means that the lake is unusable during that condition.

Our federal Environment Ministers department have told me that they cannot help which I don't believe.
